SMOKING POLICY

The Jennings McCall Center complex is a smoke-free campus. There is no smoking permitted in the individual apartments or individual patios/balconies and no smoking is permitted in the building or on the grounds.

PET POLICY

Dogs are allowed to reside in 1st floor apartments only. Cats may reside in 1st and 2nd floor apartments. Dogs and cats cannot weigh more than 25 pounds. The resident may not have more than 1 pet at any time. Residents agree to pay a \$500 non-refundable fee for the privilege of having a pet in their apartment. Resident agrees to pay for damages in excess of the \$500 fee, at the time they vacate.

FIREARM POLICY

Possession of firearms by residents of the Jennings McCall Retirement Center is permitted provided that:

- a) The resident has not demonstrated in any way that possession of these firearm(s) presents a clear and present danger to themselves or other residents or the staff.
- b) All firearm(s) must be secured in a locked cupboard or gun cabinet to be provided by the resident and any ammunition is stored separately from the firearm(s). We strongly encourage and request firearm(s) to be kept secured offsite and not on the premises.
- c) All firearm(s) must be kept within the apartment and not be worn or concealed for purposes of transporting them in or around other areas of the facility.

PRIVATE PAY POLICY

Jennings McCall Center complex is a private pay facility. We do not accept Medicaid. Rent is paid on a month-to-month basis – there is no lease and no buy-in.
